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## *Compliance –CoR Implementation*

### Unit of Competency:

- TLIF0003 Develop and implement policies and procedures to ensure chain of responsibility compliance

### Overview

This course consist of a unit of competency in the Transport and Logistics Training Package; it is delivered in a classroom environment, encouraging interaction and knowledge sharing between participants.

This course is targeted at senior management, compliance managers, directors, board members and auditors of freight forwarding companies whose role includes responsibility for compliance by the Regulator or who may be held professionally or personally responsible under CoR.

### Who is this course for?

Transport company employers/directors who have responsibility for implementing and ensuring compliance under CoR.

Participants must have:

- Substantial supervisory or scheduling experience and have current access to an active worksite
- Analytical skills to identify features of compliance systems as applied to the workplace
- Strong literacy skills in order to interpret Regulations
- Familiarity with technology required to manage systems

In order to successfully complete this course, Pentrans Consulting requires participants to hold TLIF0002 Administer chain of responsibility policies and procedures, or substantial experience.

### Course content

- Regulation, legislation, permits, licences
- Parties in the extended liability provisions of HVNL
- Breaches and consequences under CoR
- Duties and responsibilities of all parties in the chain
- Development and implementation of workplace policies, procedures and industry best practice to ensure compliance

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## Learning outcomes

On completion of the course participants should be able to:

- Identify and access relevant regulations, legislation and workplace procedures
- Identify and access sources of information to enable development and completion of documents and logs
- Ensure continuous improvement and implementation of policies, procedures and documentation to manage CoR
- Supervise monitoring of consequence under chain of responsibility legislation
- Maintain compliance with HVNL

## Assessment

Participants engage in:

- Problem solving activities and scenarios
- Written questions
- Group participation
- Work based project

## Award

## Course duration

1 day classroom

The work based project must be completed in the participant's own time and may require up to 30 hours
