Load Handling – shift, load and secure cargo

Units of Competency:

- TLIA1001 Secure cargo
- TLID1001 Shift materials safely using manual handling methods
- TLID1002 Shift a load using manually-operated equipment
- TLID2004 Load and unload goods/cargo

Overview

This course consists of units of competency in the Transport and Logistics Training Package; it is delivered in a classroom environment, encouraging interaction and knowledge sharing between participants, with practical application of skills in an actual or simulated work environment.
